The Onderdonk Family Memorial Scholarship was established in 1989 by former UTSA faculty member, Dr. Martha S. Jones, in honor of the maternal side of her family, many of whom were educators. Dr. Jones established the scholarship to assist students during the student teaching semester.

- Must be enrolled at The University of Texas at San Antonio (UTSA), part-time or full-time, for at least two semesters prior to the student teaching semester.
- Must be student teaching in the semester for which the award will be given.
- Must submit a completed application form along with the documents requested below by the application deadline.
