One \$500 scholarship to be awarded at the end of the fall 2009 semester.

2009-2010 APPLICATION DEADLINES:

November 2, 2009 for fall 2009 student teachers

To be eligible for this scholarship you must meet the following requirements:

- Must be enrolled at UTSA as an undergraduate senior seeking a B.S. in Kinesiology with an emphasis in physical education (K-12) or a post-baccalaureate student who has returned to complete student teaching during the first full semester after obtaining their B.S. in Kinesiology at UTSA.
- Must have completed all required coursework with the exception of student teaching.
- If enrolled as an undergraduate senior, must have applied for graduation by the appropriate deadline established by the University's Office of the Registrar.
- Must be currently enrolled in student teaching and pursuing all-level physical education teacher certification.
- Must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Must submit required application materials (see below) by the application deadline.
- If selected as an award recipient, student must successfully complete the student teaching semester and attend the COEHD Induction to the Profession Ceremony where the award will be given.
