

# THE ENDOWED PYTHAGORAS SCHOLARSHIP FOR MATH TEACHERS

**2009-10 APPLICATION DEADLINE: Monday, March 2, 2009**

Col Jean M. and Lt Col Philip J. Piccione USAF Ret. established this scholarship in the hopes of encouraging students to pursue a teaching degree in the field of math or math-science.

**To be eligible for this scholarship you must meet the following requirements:**

- Must be enrolled full-time (12 hours) at The University of Texas at San Antonio.
- Must be an undergraduate junior or senior student actively pursuing a secondary teaching certificate in math or math/science.
- Must be a US citizen or permanent resident and a resident of the state of Texas.
- Must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of at least a 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- Preference will be given to students who demonstrate financial need as determined by the UTSA Financial Aid office. \*

\* You are not required to demonstrate financial need to receive this scholarship. However, among equally qualified applicants, students with financial need will be prioritized. Determination of financial need is based on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). FAFSA applications for the 2009-10 academic year will be accepted starting January 1, 2009. Please submit your FAFSA as early as possible.
